Beginning with the 2019 Summer Camp Season – all out of council fees no longer exist. The same fee will apply to both Denver Area Council and Out of Council Scouts.

\*2018 summer camp fees will be valid if your troop signs up by August 31, 2018.

#### Camp Cris Dobbins Troops - \$385 per Scout\*

#### Camp Cortlandt Troops - \$335 per Scout\*

Unit Deposit - \$100.00 non-refundable deposit due at time of sign up to hold your summer camp reservation. Fee will be credited to your 2019 summer camp fees.

**November 5, 2018** - \$50.00 (non-refundable) deposit per camper for number of Scouts listed.

February 4, 2019, additional payment of \$100.00 per camper for the registered number of Scouts is due.

April 1, 2019, additional \$100.00 per camper for the registered number of Scouts is due.

May 6, 2019, outstanding balance for each camper and adult is due.

#### Adult fees:

1-20 Scouts - 2 free adults and any additional adults - \$200 each

21-30 Scouts - 2 free adults and 1 additional adult - \$75 each; additional adults - \$200 each

31-40 Scouts - 2 free adults and 2 additional adults - \$75 each; additional adults - \$200 each

41-50 Scouts - 2 free adults and 3 additional adults - \$75 each; additional adults - \$200 each

51-60 Scouts - 2 free adults and 4 additional adults - \$75 each; additional adults - \$200 each

61-70 Scouts - 2 free adults and 5 additional adults - \$75 each; additional adults - \$200 each

### **REFUNDS/CANCELLATIONS:**

Scouts cancelled before May 16, 2019 will be refunded full amount less \$50 non-refundable deposit.

After deadline - No fees will be refunded unless documented by a medical doctor or a death in the family. Scoutmaster or Camp Contact Person should request all refunds.

The \$50 per Scout deposit is non-refundable at any time, but may be applied to other troop members as long as the unit's total registration count does not go down.

"No Show" Scouts. If you have "No Show" Scouts at your 2019 summer camp check in, causing your overall number to decrease from pre-registration number, your unit may be subject to a \$100 per "No Show" Scout fee in addition to the full camp fee.

Refunds while attending camp. If a Scout or participant becomes ill or has an injury while attending camp and is sent home prior to Wednesday by order of the camp medical director, the Scout will receive a 50% refund of fees paid. If a Scout or participant goes home after Wednesday, they WILL NOT receive any type of refund (camp and program fees). Scouts or participants who leave camp for behavioral issues, by their own choice, or for any other reason, WILL NOT receive a refund (camp or program fees).
