

Outstanding Scouter (Selection Guideline):

- You can register your guests for the Dinner and identify your Outstanding Scouters online at www.arapahoedistrict.org or can fill out the registration form and return it to the Hamilton Headquarters Council Office. Selection deadline is Wednesday February 24, 2010.
- Has a scouter or scouters in your unit made or are they making significant contributions to your unit? For example, have they been a great Cubmaster, or great Committee Chairman, or do they get involved in many other positive roles and responsibilities within your unit?
- Recognize your OUTSTANDING CONTRIBUTORS by inviting them to the District Dinner for the recognition they deserve! Talk this over with your Unit Committee and make your selection this month.

District Award of Merit (Nomination Guideline):

- Submit a District Award of Merit Nomination form to the Hamilton Headquarters Council Office by Wednesday February 24, 2010.
- Have they made or are they making significant contributions to your unit or another unit; e.g. have they been a great Cubmaster, or great Committee Chairman, or do they get involved in many other positive roles and responsibilities within the unit
- Have they made notable contributions at the District or Council level; e.g:
 - Have they served in key staff roles at District or Council Events such as Pow Wow, Chautauqua, Day Camp, Camporee, Klondoree, etc.
 - Key staff roles include Director, Organizer, Range Officer, Chairman, Coordinator, etc.
 - Have they served on the District Committee
 - Have they been on the District Training Staff
- Outside of scouting, are they performing service to youth in the community; e.g. Business, Professional, Civic, Religious, Educational, Fraternal & Veterans
- These are guidelines, if you feel a Scouter has made notable contributions at the unit and district level, then please fill out a District Award of Merit Nomination form.

Spirit of Polaris Award (Nomination Guideline):

- Submit a Spirit of Polaris Nomination form to the Hamilton Headquarters Council Office by Wednesday February 24, 2010.
- Have they made or are they making significant contributions to your unit or another unit; e.g. have they been a great Cubmaster, or great Committee Chairman, or do they get involved in many other positive roles and responsibilities
- Have they begun to volunteer for District responsibilities; e.g:
 - Have they served as staff at any District Events such as Pow Wow, Chautauqua, Day Camp, Camporee, Klondoree, etc.
 - Staff roles include Instructor, General Staff, Committee Member, Support Personnel, etc.
 - Have they or are they serving on the District Committee
 - Have they or are they on the District Training Staff
- These are guidelines, if you feel a scouter has made notable contributions at the unit and begun to make contributions at the district level, then please fill out a Spirit of Polaris Award Nomination form

Footsteps of the Founder Award (Nomination Guideline):

- Submit a Footsteps of the Founder Award Nomination form to the Hamilton Headquarters Council Office by Wednesday February 24, 2010.
- Anyone can nominate a unit leader
- This is a recognition for a volunteer being an exceptional unit leader. Their devotion to scouting is clearly apparent not only by the significant investment of their time, but also by the depth of their heart and display of scout spirit. They are a source of inspiration and motivation to youth as they make their way to Eagle and to other adults who will carry on the legacy of scouts in the footsteps of our founder.
