Bird Study

You will study birds in several Colorado habitats from grassland to mountains and learn details such as why some birds migrate and why some choose to stay over winter. In one class and series of outings, complete requirements for Bird Study. Learn about birding, discover birds of the area and make a bird feeder. Read Bird Study badge book prior to class. Bring binoculars if available, lightweight spiral notebook at least 5"x 8", blue card, pencils with erasers, paper, badge worksheets, Class B uniform and water bottle. You must attend

first session which will be classroom study and a walk. A variety of dates throughout the summer for bird hikes with the Audubon Society or the class instructor will be available to complete bird watching requirements. Dates available at class time. Fee includes Colorado Bird Field Guide and feeder supplies.
